#### What do Course Directors do?

Course Directors (CDs) are responsible for coordinating and conducting CAOHC-approved, assessment-based certificate training courses for Occupational Hearing Conservationists. Course Directors work as team members in hearing loss-prevention programs.

- Training workshops are held 1 or 2 times per year.
- Use CAOHC videos to assist you in teaching the course.
- CAOHC registers class participants, provides administrative support, mentors and helps with marketing assistance.

- 1. You must be licensed in nursing, medicine or audiology... details below
- 2. You must be certified... details below
- 3. You must have a minimum of 1,000 hours of experience in hearing loss prevention... details below

#### ...details

- Must be Licensed in the United States for the practice of medicine, nursing or audiology or have a current membership in The American Industrial Hygiene Association, Institute of Noise Control Engineering, or the American Society of Safety Engineers.
- 2. Must have a current certification through:
  - \* American Board of Occupational Health Nurses
  - \* American Board of Audiology
  - \* American Board of Industrial Hygiene
  - \* American Board of Otolaryngology
  - \* American Board of Preventative Medicine (Occupational Medicine)
  - \* American Speech-Language-Hearing Association (Audiology)
  - \* Board of Certified Safety Professionals
  - \* Institute of Noise Control Engineering
- Must have a minimum of one year equivalent (1,000 hours) work
  experience in occupational hearing conservation activities within the
  past five years.
