Proposed Change for Inspections

A [notice](#) published on August 30, proposes OSHA make amendments and allow employers to appoint an employee or third party to accompany the CSHO during a physical workplace inspection. This would help ensure OSHA obtains necessary information about worksite conditions and hazards during an inspection.
